Reinforce Understanding

3.1 Small Group • Group 1

With my small group, I can write and describe a ratio that compares two quantities — one step at a time, with support.

Worked model

1. Count each group. pens = 10 pencils = 4
2. Write them in the order the question asks — pens FIRST.
3. Write all three forms: 10 to 4 • 10 : 4 • 10/4
4. Simplify: divide both terms by 2. 10 : 4 → 5 : 2

Answer: The ratio of pens to pencils is 5 : 2 in simplest form.
